

## **SENIOR PRIVILEGES**

Seniors at Granby Jr./Sr. High School will be allowed to leave school grounds for lunch if they meet the criteria listed below. Any infraction of school rules will result in suspension of privileges for that individual and/or discipline.

### **TERMS:**

- A.** Each student granted senior privileges must sign a release form and have their parent do the same.
- B.** Each student must leave school grounds immediately after exiting the building. No loitering in the parking lot will be permitted.
- C.** This is a privilege not a right. It can and will be revoked if misconduct occurs in the classroom or outside of it.
- D.** An average of 70 must be achieved by the student in the previous marking period.
- E.** If a student accumulates seven (7) demerits, his/her privilege will be revoked.
- F.** If the student gets suspended from school his/her senior privilege will be revoked.
- G.** A student who has been cited for a surchargable motor vehicle offense within three (3) months of the start date for privileges will be deemed ineligible.
- H.** A student with privileges who is charged with speeding will be subject to immediate loss of senior privileges.
- I.** Privileges will be subject to weather conditions as determined by the Jr./Sr. High School administration.
- J.** Students with senior privileges will only be allowed to leave campus in cars belonging to students attending Granby Jr./Sr. High School.
