

ADMISSION TO SCHOOL SPONSORED AND SUPERVISED EVENTS

Students are advised that, at the discretion of the administration, a Passive Alcohol Screener (PAS) may be used as a requirement for admission to selected events.

The screener will only be administered by members of the Granby Public Schools' staff and is considered to be non-invasive because it does not use anything that must be placed in the mouth. Students will speak into this "microphone-like" device to verify that he/she has not recently had alcohol to drink.

Any student or guest accompanying the student who refuses to take the screening will not be allowed to attend. If alcohol is detected, the student will be detained until a parent/guardian comes for him/her, and he/she will be subject to disciplinary action.
