AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY SCHOLARSHIP

For children of Veterans in Massachusetts. Auxiliary will contribute toward the expenses of higher education of any child, step-child, grandchild, step-grandchild great grandchild, step-great grandchild, not under the age of 16, nor over the age of 22 who is related to a U.S. Veteran (living or deceased) who served in the Armed Forces.

AWARD: (1) \$750 and (10) \$200 and a Past Presidents' Parley Nursing Scholarship in the amount of \$200.
