

NEW FACILITIES PLANNING

School Building Committee

The School Committee will request the creation of a school building committee for specific school projects. These Building Committees act as the administrative authority for the projects, subject to approval of various actions by the town meeting.

The School Building Committee has the following responsibilities:

- I. To study and make recommendations with respect to school building needs.
- II. To review thoroughly with the Superintendent and the School Committee the educational requirements in relation to school buildings.
- III. To review previous studies and initiate needed studies with or without consultative assistance.
- IV. To employ the services of architects and cost estimators and such other professional assistance as it may deem necessary.

Staff Planning

Arrangements will be made by the Superintendent, working through principals, for the school staff to contribute in the planning of school building projects. Teachers will be given the opportunity to submit suggestions for possible inclusion in the educational specifications.
