

TITLE 1 – PARENT INVOLVEMENT

The Granby Public Schools, in an effort to increase student achievement through participation in the federally-funded Title I program, will provide many opportunities for parental involvement in the planning, implementation and assessment of the Title I program. These opportunities will include, but not necessarily be limited to, the following:

1. Information

All parents will be kept regularly informed about the activities of the Title I program and about their child's progress.

2. Program Development and Assessment

A steering committee comprised of parents of Title I students, members of the Title I staff and the Title I Director will conduct an annual self-assessment of the program's effectiveness. The data gathered from the self-assessment (to include parents, teachers, administrators) will be used by the steering committee to make recommendations regarding possible revisions for the following year.

3. Parental Involvement/Education Activities

Parents will be afforded the opportunity to receive education in strategies to assist their children at home in areas covered by the Title I program, as well as other parenting issued as determined by the steering committee. These educational activities will be provided at flexible times and sites as determined by a needs assessment.
