

FACILITIES DEVELOPMENT GOALS

The School Committee believes that any educational program is influenced greatly by the environment in which it functions. The development of quality educational programs and school facilities that help to implement the program must go hand-in-hand.

Therefore, it is the School Committee's goal to provide the facilities needed for the number of students in the Granby Public Schools, and to provide the kind of facilities that will best support and accommodate the educational programs.

In planning facilities, the School Committee recognizes that capital outlay funds are limited, and that priorities must be established to make the best use of the school renovation/construction dollars. The School Committee's first objective will be to develop plans that adequately provide for all programs. Whenever possible, the cultural as well as educational needs of the community will be considered in planning facility renovation or construction.
