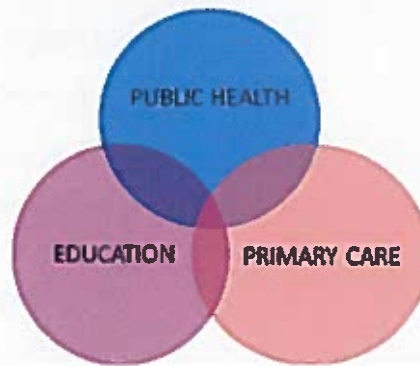


Are You Interested in a Career in School Nursing?



A nurse in a school setting is responsible for:

- Illness assessment and care
- Injury prevention, triage and treatment
- Individualized healthcare planning and case management for students with special health needs
- Medication administration and monitoring
- Community health promotion
- Communicable disease prevention and control
- Staff education and training
- Family health education
- Consulting with providers along with family for medical, social, behavioral, and emotional issues
- Collaboration with school personnel and administration to ensure health and academic positive outcomes for students
- Monitoring and ensuring immunization compliance
- Health policy development and evaluation
- Collaborating with interdisciplinary crisis teams, wellness committees, and health agencies

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
