

PUBLIC GIFTS TO THE SCHOOL

The Superintendent with the approval of the School Committee will have authority to accept gifts and offers of equipment for the schools in the name of the School Committee when the gift is of educational value. In the case of gifts from industry, business, or special interest groups, no extensive advertising or promotion may be involved in any donation to the schools.

Gifts that would involve changes in school plants, sites or public advertising will be subject to School Committee approval.

Gifts will automatically become the property of the Granby Public Schools. Any gift of cash, whether or not intended by the donor for a specific purpose, will be handled as a separate account and expended at the discretion of the School Committee, as provided by law.

The School Committee directs the Superintendent to assure that an appropriate expression of thanks is given all donors.
