#### I. Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at 6:39 P.M. All Present.

## Consent Agenda:

#### II. Visitor's Comments:

Any citizen wishing to speak before the Committee must sign in with the Administrative Assistant prior to the opening of the Regular Session of the School Committee. The visitor will identify themselves by name and address and shall speak for no longer than three (3) minutes. (See Granby Public School Committee Policy BEDG).

A member of the audience would like to see child care available when the public is invited to attend a school committee meeting. Mr. Sullivan, principal of the Jr./Sr. High School will see if there are any National Honor Society members that would be available. Mr. Evren commented that our meetings are video-taped by GCAM and can be watched at any time. Currently the East Meadow outside equipment is a being stored in a big bin that houses the balls that are used. The carpenters union is donating their time to construct a shed to be used for larger equipment. The material was purchased by East Meadow that will be used for the shed.

# III. New Business:

A. Professional Teacher Status – Alyssa Mullin - Lesley Mahoney Superintendent Stanton noted that today was an exciting day for the District. A ribbon cutting ceremony was held earlier today for the dedication of the East Meadow School. Superintendent Stanton presented Ms. Alyssa Mullin with a bouquet of flowers for her achievement of reaching Professional Teacher Status, Mr. Evren also congratulated Ms. Mullin. Mr. Sullivan accepted the bouquet for Ms. Mahoney. Ms. Mahoney had a prior engagement and was not able to attend.

- C. Mr. Sullivan advised that the \$1,500 donation was an incentive with Lifetouch as part of a contract signed by the previous principal that was never used. Principal. Sullivan followed up with LifeTouch and requested that the incentive be sent to

the district as a donation in the form of a check. The donation will be used to enhance instructional technology in the school.

Discussion on organizing research for class size. This will be discussed at our District Instructional meeting on September 25<sup>th</sup>. We will be discussing the time line, metrics, district assessments and data from students and staff will be collected.

B. New agenda format

Superintendent Stanton did not find an agenda that would align with our Strategic Plan. She suggested creating our own agenda. The committee would like to see the Strategic Goal next to the agenda item. Mr. Evren and Ms. Stanton will work on creating an agenda for the next meeting.

C. School Committee Goals

Mr. Evren stated that all of our goals have not been met. Would like to keep the goals we have and add short term goals for the school committee that would be completed within a year.

D. Granby Jr./Sr. High School roof

Discussion regarding the high school roof. Last year some of our sporting events had to be cancelled because of rain water on the gym floor. When we get a hard rain it also starts raining in the gym, class rooms and the hall ways. The money has been allocated to repair the roof. The Selectboard has to appoint a roof committee to oversee the project. At this time this has not been done. Mr. Evren would like the school committee be part of organizing the committee. He would like to see a timeline down on paper.
