

USE OF PESTICIDES ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

- I. Pesticides shall not be applied indoors while children are on the property, except for anti-micro pesticides such as bleach; rodenticides placed in tamper resistant baits; insecticidal baits; ready-to-use dusts, gels, or powder formulations, and certain lower risk pesticides.
- II. Pesticides shall not be applied on the outdoor property of a school, daycare center, or school aged childcare program while children are located in, on, or adjacent to the area of the pesticide application.
- III. All parents, staff, and children will be provided with standard written notification, which may occur via electronic means, of any pesticide application made outdoors on school property at least two (2) working days before the application is to take place. The notification will also be posted in a common area. The information contained in the standard written notification will be obtained from the licensed pesticide applicator who performs the work.
- IV. The same notification requirements given in III will be followed for all indoor pesticide applications except in the case of anti-microbial pesticides such as bleach, rodenticides placed in tamper resistant baits, insecticidal baits, ready-to-use dusts, gels, or powder formulations, and certain lower risk pesticides.
