## Things to know....

1. Two [Quick Reference Guides \(QRGs\) to the 2017 Curriculum Framework for Mathematics](#) are now available! The first, "[Fractions Learning Progression in Grades 3–5](#)," describes the learning trajectory from the conceptual foundations of fractions to fluency with fractional operations. The second QRG, "[Standard Algorithms for Addition and Subtraction](#)," summarizes the progression of standards related to developing a conceptual understanding of the standard algorithms for addition and subtraction. Each two-page QRG is designed to be widely accessible and easy to distribute, and additional QRGs will be released on a rolling basis throughout the school year.
2. [Grade-by-Grade Explanations of the 2017 Revisions to the ELA/Literacy and Mathematics Frameworks](#) are now available on the [main Frameworks page](#)! These documents, which supplement the previously released "Highlights" resources, provide detailed explanations of all revisions made to the 2010 standards for each grade level in 2017. Both Grade-by-Grade Explanations previously appeared on the Board of Elementary and Secondary Education site as documentation of the standards review process; the ELA/literacy document on the main Frameworks page is identical to the one previously available on the Board site, while the math document has undergone minor edits.
3. Some of our 2017–2018 standards implementation networks still have space available! Please note that logistical details such as dates and locations have changed slightly for a few of the networks since they were first announced. If you have already signed up for a network, you will be notified directly of any changes that affect you. If you have not yet signed up or if you would like to encourage others to sign up, please use the attached version of the flyer, which is current.
